

BHS EXAMS

BHS Stage 1

Minimum age for entry is 14 years old.

He, or she, must understand the basic principles of horse care and, working under supervision, must show some knowledge and practice of looking after a well mannered horse in the stable or at grass.

The candidate must be capable of riding a quiet, experienced horse or pony in an enclosed space.

Cost £35 per session which includes riding and lecture, practical and theory.

BHS Stage II

Minimum age for entry is 16 years old.

Before entering the riding section of this examination the candidate must have passed the BHS Riding and Road Safety examination.

The candidate must understand the general management and requirement of horses for their health and well being. Working under regular but not constant supervision, the candidates should be able to carry out the care of a stable and grass kept horse during all seasons of the year.

BHS Stage III

Minimum age for entry is 17 years old.

The candidate must show ability to look after and ride up to 4 horses under a variety of circumstance. He or she should be tactful, yet effective, understanding the reasons of his or her actions, both in horse care and while riding.

BHS Preliminary Test

Minimum Age is at 18 years old.

Candidates are examined in their ability to give instruction in basic subjects. In order to enter the Preliminary Teaching Test a candidate must have passed the H K and R Stage II examination.

BHS Preliminary Teacher (BHSPTC)

The certificate is award to those passing the hors Knowledge and riding Stage III and the Preliminary Teaching Test. This qualifies the holder at a trainee Teacher lever.
