



Arrive - Compete - Leave

Advice and Guidance to be adhered to by all competitors for our Show Jumping Competition – Sunday 12th July 2020

- **Support** - 1 x Rider and 1 x Support person per horse, sorry, no spectators.
- **Riders and Support to bring their own PPE** - Mask, Gloves and Hand Sanitiser. For use in situations where Social Distancing is not possible (Retrieving injured or loose horses for example).
- **Numbers** - Numbers will be posted with times, please remember your number – no printed numbers will be given out – you will need to give your number to the steward.
- **Lorry Parking** - Please leave 5m space between lorries, tying up on the passenger side only. Please follow instructions of event staff.
- **Dogs** - Strictly on leads at all times.
- **Refreshments** are available from Busy Birds Catering stand, please adhere to their Covid 19 policy.
- **Photography** - Dorset Photo Events www.dorsetphotoevent.co.uk will be in attendance but for online sales only.
- **Toilet & Welfare Facilities** - Please adhere to all instructions – use your own lorry facilities if you have them available.
- **Arena Stewards** - All our stewards are volunteers, please respect personal space of all stewards at all times. Competitors who disobey any Judge or Officials decision could be refused entry into any future RAC Saddle Club competitions.
- **Warm up areas** - Warm up areas are restricted to numbers. Maximum competitor numbers will be displayed on the entrance and controlled by stewards. **No Trainers or Coaches in warm up areas.**
- **Warm up** will be initially in the grass paddock below the competition arenas, you will then be asked to move through to the jumping warm up arena by the steward. There are to be no more than 4 riders in the warm up arena at any one time. There will be a fence steward provided to lower/raise warm up fences.
- **Riding** - Whilst mounted please keep your Social Distance from all competitors, even if you are in the same bubble - **Our Stewards do not know.**
- **No spectating** from within warm up arena.
- **Course Plans** - Posted online and on large onsite boards.
- **Course Walking** - Keep your Social Distance and DO NOT TOUCH FENCES OR POLES.
- **Arena** - Please note that there is a separate entrance and exit in the rubber arena.
- **Rider falls** - If a rider falls off and needs assistance, their support person may enter the arena. If the rider is deemed to be seriously injured, the support person must signal the first aider, who will be at the gate, for assessment. The support person will need to call the ambulance if necessary.

- **Rosettes** - If awarded, will not be handed out at the event, but can be obtained by emailing liz@racsaddleclub.co.uk with your address.
- **Waste Management** - Members are encouraged to take home all their waste.
- **Toilets** - Hand washing or sanitizer available **both** outside before entering and inside. Please follow all instructions.
- **Hand Sanitiser** - Riders are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitiser.
- **Any person disregarding the above guidance will be asked to leave the venue immediately.**

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
