PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded to 10th in each class or section where relevant.

Wessex Connemara Performance Day rosettes 1-6th in each height section for registered Connemara ponies and registered Part-bred Connemara ponies. Please make a note on Equo that you are entering this qualifier.

Classes to be divided into sections, where there are sufficient entrants.

Prizes in kind to 3rd place.

Rosettes to 10th place.

1st place rosette to the highest placed military rider in each section.

WESSEX CONNEMARA PERFORMANCE DAY AND SARACEN CONNEMARA EVENTING CHAMPIONSHIP'S QUALIFER

Wessex Performance Day – Any registered Connemara or part bred Connemara entered in this ODE is automatically entered into the Wessex Connemara Performance Day and will be eligible to win 1^{st} - 6^{th} rosettes in each height category according to your final score. Please make sure you make it clear on your entry you are riding a Connemara/Part bred – Good Luck!

Qualifier- These classes are qualifiers for The Saracen Connemara Eventing Championships to be held on 10th/11th September 2022 at Swalcliffe Park, Oxfordshire OX15 5EX (<u>Swalcliffe</u> <u>Park Equestrian</u>) To qualify you must be placed in the top 10 of your section or have a double clear. Please ensure that you mark on your entry that you are riding a Connemara/Part bred if you want to be eligible.

In order to compete at the championship, the owner of the pony needs to be an Adult/Junior Member of the British Connemara Pony Society. Ponies must be pure, part-bred or over height Connemaras, which are registered or over stamped on the BCPS database. The pony must be in the correct ownership. RULES AND CONDITIONS

This event will be run in accordance with the rules for **British Eventing 2022**, except where stated otherwise in this schedule. It is the competitor's responsibility to familiarise themselves with BE rules.

VACCINATIONS: ALL COMPETITORS MUST BE AWARE OF THE CURRENT VACCINATION RULE (BE RULE 10.2.1)

Hat Rule: All competitors must wear an approved jockey skull (see BE rule 7.2.2) to a current following standard –

British – PAS 015 (1998 or 2011, VG1 040 2004 Or 2014-1 - with BSI Kitemark or Inspec IC mark American –All ASTM F1163 2004a onwards and SEI mark SNELL 2001or 2016 Australia & New Zealand – AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards with SAI Global Mark

Body Protectors as per BE standards (Rule 7.3) must be worn for the XC phase. Dressage – Gloves must be worn.

Competitors must provide their own bibs and print out their own numbers.

The decision of the judges will be final.

The Organisers reserve the right to cancel the event or alter timings of phases & to divide or amalgamate classes according to entries or to refuse entry for any reason whatsoever.

If the event has to be cancelled before starting, entry fees will be refunded less £5 admin fee. In adverse weather, competitors are to check with the organiser or our website that the event is being run.

No horse/pony may compete in more than 1 class. Riders may not compete more than 4 horses per day.

Rosettes and dressage sheets can be sent out to winners. Please bring with you a large stamped self-addressed envelope with you and place in the bin outside the dressage warm up arena.

Neither the Organisers, nor the Landowners, nor any person acting on their behalf shall be responsible for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.

Dressage sheets will **not** be released until final class results are announced, we can post your sheet to you if you bring an SAE or £1 for postage.
