Accredited by the British Horse Society, the programme offers recognised qualifications and a positive pathway forward — with many young people leaving calmer, more focused, and better prepared for education, work, or training.

Empowering young people through horses, nature and education.

Our Alternative Provision offers a calm, supportive environment where young people can reconnect with learning, rebuild confidence, and discover their potential.

Through equine-assisted mentoring, outdoor learning, and personalised support, we help those who struggle in traditional education re-engage both academically and emotionally.

Programmes are tailored to individual needs and may include 1:1 or small group sessions, supporting young people with anxiety, school refusal, additional needs, or those transitioning back into education.

Students can work towards recognised qualifications such as Functional Skills, Personal Development Qualifications, and British Horse Society awards, while developing confidence, resilience, and a sense of purpose.
